

## **Report of Field Survey**

**Destination: Villages Surrounding Krishnagar**

Date: 23<sup>rd</sup> March and 24<sup>th</sup> March 2023

### **Introduction:**

The field survey cum excursion to the villages around Krishnagar was conducted by Department of Political Science of Krishnagar Women's College with 2<sup>nd</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Semester Hons.. students, for 2 days from 23.03.2024 to 24.03.2024. The field survey cum excursion was aimed to provide students with practical exposure and hands-on experience in primary data collection and preparation of field report and also to give the students an idea about involvement of the women in the Panchayats at village level in West Bengal for the partial fulfilment of their syllabus. Total 96 students and 1 faculty member along with 2 Non Teaching Staff participated in the excursion. The topic of the survey was "Participation of women in Panchayats of West Bengal"

### **Objectives:**

- To gain first-hand knowledge about women at village level of West Bengal
- To have a knowledge about data collection.
- To be enabled to do data analysis to prepare a field report.
- To have an idea about Panchayats of West Bengal.
- To have an idea about women's' participation in Panchayats of West Bengal
- To have experience about women empowerment in village level.

### **Procedure:**

The students gathered in the College . From there they were taken to the villages surrounding Krishnagar in Battery Operated eRikshaws (commonly called Toto in West Bengal). The students visited Kalirhat, Durgapur and Senpur Villages in Krishnagar I Block and Dhubulia and Nakshipara Gram Panchayats in Krishnagar II Block. The students both visited the Gram Panchayat offices to have an idea of the functioning of the Gram Panchayats and did house to house survey to have an the first hand idea about village women, their education, Aspiration, Empowerment, etc. Each day , the students , accompanied by the Teacher and Non Teaching Staff started around 11 AM. For home visits, they were divided into groups with each group having 10 students. The visits continued till 4PM in the evening,

after which they came back to the College in the same eRikshaw. The data analysis and preparation of the field report was done later in the College.

**Importance and Learning Outcomes:**

- Throughout the survey, students actively engaged with the survey procedure. The experience fostered a deeper understanding of the villages and village people, Panchayat System in West Bengal, Participation of women in the Panchayats.
- The home visit helped the students a have a first hand experience about village women, their education aspiration, work, self help and empowerment as a whole.
- Students acquire knowledge of preparation of filed report.
- The field survey cum excursion provided students with a memorable and enriching experience, fostering a spirit of inquiry, curiosity, and lifelong learning and helped to know the people of our country better.
