STATUTORY DECLARATION UNDER THE RTI ACT 2005

Section 4 (1) (b) of RTI ACT 2005 covers the statutory declaration of Dr. Natasa Dasgupta, Principal, Krishnagar Women's College, Aurobinda Sarani, Krishnagar, 701101, District: Nadia, West Bengal, Website: www.kwc.edu.in. Krishnagar Women's College is approved and recognized by the UGC and is affiliated with the University of Kalyani. It operates in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by the Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal, under the West Bengal Universities and Colleges (Administration and Regulation) Act of March 22, 2017. As a government-aided institution, our financial transactions are audited by government-nominated auditors. The college is managed by a Governing Body as mandated by the abovementioned Act. We have an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and various committees to ensure the smooth conduct of routine activities and maintain campus discipline in compliance with government provisions. All institutional committees are under statutory bodies. Information about the college is publicly accessible and can be obtained by any citizen of India.

Citizens can seek information regarding the activities of the college by submitting a written request with details like Name, address, contact telephone number and particulars of the information sought. The reason for seeking information need not be given. The duly signed request may be addressed to the State Public Information Officer, Krishnagar Women's College, Krishnagar, Nadia, 741101 along with the required fee of Rs.10/-. Copies of documents will be charged according to the rate fixed by the State Information Commission, Govt. of West Bengal. Payment is to be made by Treasury Challan/Bank draft/Indian Postal Order. BPL {Below Poverty Line} persons need not pay the application fee or any additional fee. In case a request for the information is refused or the request is not properly responded, an appeal can be filed with the Appellate Authority within 30 days. A second appeal lies with the State Information Commission within 90 days. There are no fees for appeals.

The Governing Body of the College formed an RTI Cell with an SPIO and Appellate Authority vide GB agenda & resolution no. 7 dated 17.7.2020 following the direction of the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo no. ED-1964/2017 dated 22.09.2017.

Information can be refused only on the following grounds (under rule 8(1) of the Act:

- a) Information, disclosure of which would prejudicially affect the sovereignty and integrity of India, the Security, strategic, scientific or economic interests of the States relation with forging State or lead to incitement of an offence;
- b) Information that has been expressly forbidden to be published by any court of law or tribunal or the disclosure of which may constitute contempt of court;
- c) Information, the disclosure of which would cause a branch of privilege of Parliament or the State legislature;
- d) Information including commercial confidence, trade secrets or intellectual property, the disclosure of which would harm the competitive position of a third party, unless the competent authority is satisfied that larger public interest warrants the disclosure of such information;
- e) Information available to a person in his fiduciary relationship, unless the competent authority is satisfied that the larger public interest warrants the disclosure of such information;
- f) Information received in confidence from foreign Government;
- g) Information the disclosure of which would enlarge the life or physical safety of any person or identify the source of information or assistance given in confidence for law enforcement or security purposes;
- h) Information which would impede the process of investigation or apprehension precaution of offenders;
- i) Cabinet papers including records of deliberations of the Council of Ministers, Secretaries and other officers;

Provided that the decisions of Council of Ministers, the person thereof, and the material on the basis of which the decision were taken shall be made public after the decision has been taken, and the matter is complete, or over:

Provided further that those matters which come under the exemptions specified in this section shall not be disclosed.

- j) Information which relates to personal information the disclosure of which has no relationship to any public activity or interest, or which would cause unwarranted invasion of the privacy of the

individual unless the Central Public Information Officer or the State Public Information Officer or the Appellate Authority, as the case may be, is satisfied that the larger public interest justifies, the disclosure of such information;

Provided that the information which cannot be denied to the Parliament or a State Legislative shall not be denied to any person.
