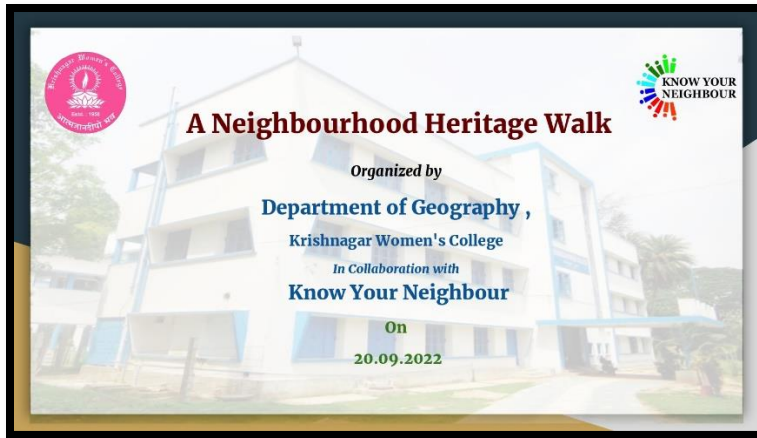

- **Most of the students of the college hail from rural areas and therefore find very little or no access to general computer education. On this realization the college enters into a MOU with WEBEL, a Govt. of WB enterprise, to bring various computer related certificate courses within the access of willing students of the college at the cost of very marginal fees to be paid by the student to WEBEL. College provides the infrastructure to WEBEL to run such courses and WEBEL, on the other hand, provides trainers, course coordinators etc. The computer training center is presently situated in the Dipti Bose Building of the campus of the college.**

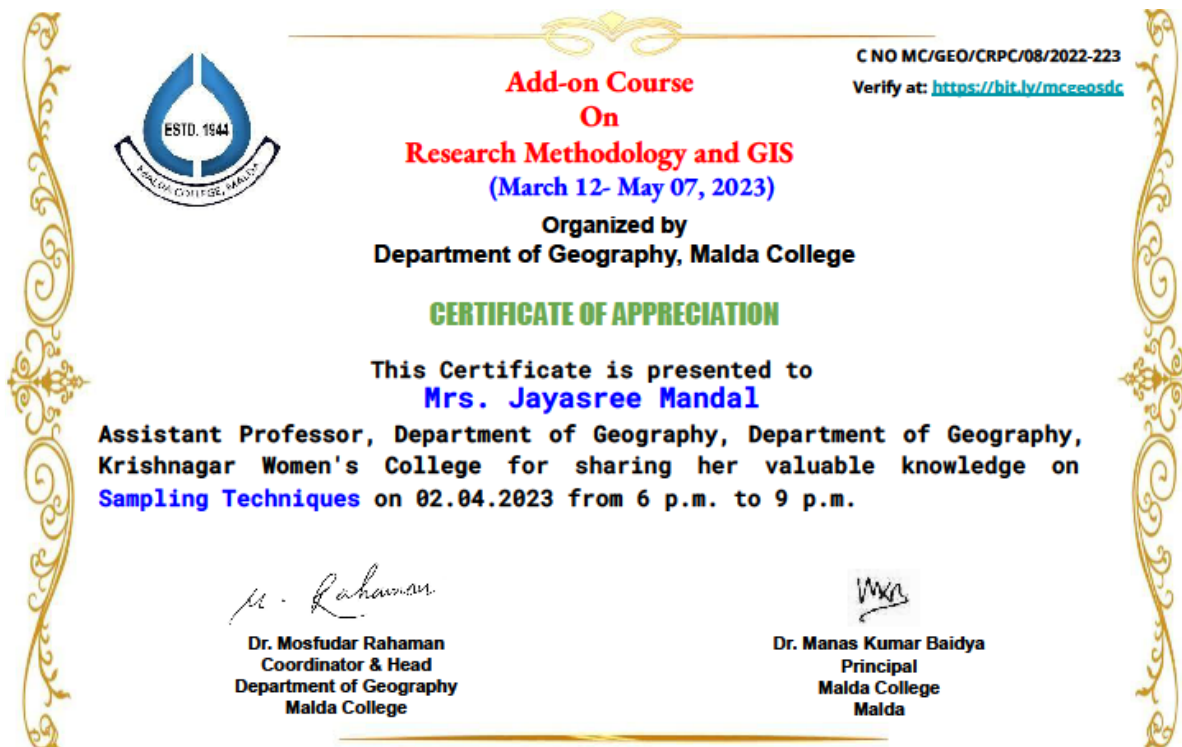
